
The EU's key funding programme for research and innovation:




1.5% EU business R&D investment



International Cooperation in the Work Programme 2023-2024

- Open to the World: any consortium can include international partner(s) for almost all topics
- 22% of topics specifically encourage International Cooperation
- Africa initiative/ Mediterranean initiative/ China flagships
- Balance openness with safeguarding European strategic autonomy and assets (Article 22.5 of HE Regulation): 31 topics restrict participation

Widening participation and strengthening the European Research Area: Policy narrative

Widening component

- Tackle the innovation divide towards a more inclusive and cohesive European research and innovation ecosystem in the European Union;
- Raise the bar of excellence and visibility for research institutions and teams in catching up countries;
- Existing disparities between R&I leading and lagging countries and regions should be reduced by institutional and systemic policy reforms.

ERA component

- Support the four objectives set out in the ERA Communication, and the implementation of the 20 actions in the ERA Policy Agenda (*Prioritising investments and reforms, Improving access to excellence, Translating R&I results into the economy, Deepening the ERA*)

Synergies with other funding programmes/work programme parts

- Horizon Europe including thematic clusters and R&I missions, in relation to the relevant actions in the ERA Policy Agenda, and of the ambition of the Pact for R&I in general;
- Cohesion policy and other similar community funding such as RRF, IPA (in particular for Widening);

Twinning Green Deal adds in directionality to the general twinning action. All the conditions remain the same except for the choice of the research topic. **The latter will have to be in line with the European Green Deal strategy actions.**

Expected outcomes

- Improved excellence capacity and resources in Widening countries enabling to close the still apparent research and innovation gap within Europe;
- Enhanced strategic networking activities between the research institutions of the Widening countries and at least two internationally-leading counterparts at EU level;
- Raised reputation, research profile and attractiveness of the coordinating institution from the Widening country and the research profile of its staff;
- Strengthened research management capacities and administrative skills of the staff working in institutions from the Widening country;




Cyprus participation in the Framework Programmes



Participation of Widening countries: a clear positive trend - overall participation




Participation of Widening countries: a clear positive trend - SME participation
