On 25 November 2021 the European Commission launched a <u>Call for Expression of Interest</u> addressed to cities, inviting them to join the <u>Mission on Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities</u> (Cities Mission). This call remains open until 31 January 2021 and cities can express their interest via an online questionnaire.

The objective of the event is to inform the cities of Cyprus on the opportunities and benefits available to them under the Cities Mission, with special attention paid to the local urban context.
