Description of the (Research) Team

The Hebrew University, the Departmen of Political Science and the School of Public Policy are leading research institutions in Israel and globally,

Expertise of the Team Leader

I have been one of the leaders in the emergence and consolidation of the field of regulation and governance. My work on diffusion, regulatory governance, and regulatory capitalism has become one of the important references in the field and elsewhere (see figure), as reflected in citations of my work. These citations come from many disciplinary fields. A Web of Science analysis reveals an impact across a wide range of fields: economics (12%); international relations (11%), environmental studies (7%), business (6%), sociology (5%), areas studies (4), and interdisciplinary social sciences (4%). Most of the citations concentrate in three fields: political science (43%), public administration, (31) and law (23%). I have played a central role in the emergence of Regulation & Governance as an interdisciplinary field. The field of "regulation and governance" and the concept of "regulatory capitalism" are now a reality in the landscape of interdisciplinary social science. For these achievements, I was awarded the first ECPR Standing Group on Regulatory Governance prize for Regulatory Studies Development. This prize was conferred in recognition of significant contributions to the advancement of knowledge in the field of regulation and governance. My contribution is also notable in three ways:

First, as a founding co-editor, with John Braithwaite and Cary Coglianese, of *Regulation & Governance* (from 2006, first volume 2007). I have been serving for 15 years now as editor, working successfully with different teams throughout these years. Our impact factor for 2019 was 3.375, which means 8/48 (Public Administration), 7/154 (Law), and 12/180 (Poli-Sci).

Second, as a founding co-chair (with Jacint Jordana) of the ECPR Standing Group on Regulatory Governance (with a listsery of 2500 members worldwide). Our six biennial international meetings thus far have attracted the participation of over 1500 scholars. We are the second-largest standing group of the ECPR. In addition, I initiated the launch of a Regulation & Governance network in the Society for the Advancement of Socio-Economics (SASE).

Third, as an editor of collection and special issues. I have edited two handbooks: The Oxford Handbook of Governance (Oxford University Press, 2012; translated into Chinese by Academic Press) and Handbook on the Politics of Regulation (Edward Elgar, 2011). Together comprising almost 100 chapters, these publications serve both as a testimony to the maturity of the field and as a platform for future development. I am also editor of three different volumes of the *Annals of the American Academy of Political and Social Sciences*.
