- Support aspiring entrepreneurs in developing innovative startup ideas.
- Promote **newcomers** to **startup** companies' creation.
- Assist startuppers in the development and validation of innovative technological ideas, as well as in exploring their business viability.

 Duration of Project Implementation: Up to 6 Months (Completion by 31 March 2026).

- Reduces the risks about startup development process.
 - ✓ Strengthen innovation capacity & commercialization of results.
- Contributes to building entrepreneurial and product development skills among the next generation of startup founders.
 - ✓ Support newcomers to the innovation ecosystem.
 - ✓ Enhance entrepreneurial and product development skills.









General Call Information

Call Budget: €500,000

○ Maximum Funding Per Project: €25,000

Funding Intensity: 100% (no own resources required).

Announcement Date: 23 July 2025.

o Deadline: Open Call until 08 October 2025, 13:00, or until budget exhaustion.









Beneficiaries

- ☐ Individuals legally residing & working in areas under Republic of Cyprus control.
- Each individual may receive funding only in one (1) Project.
- ☐ Degree holders (Bachelor, Master, or PhD) within the **last three (3) years**.
- □ Not eligible to apply:
 - Coordinators in RIF innovation programmes (PRE-SEED, SEED, INNOVATE, DISRUPT, BOOST, FAST TRACK INNOVATION).
 - Shareholders of existing companies. X









Conditions for Participation

- Mandatory participation in Innovation Bootcamps (training seminars free of charge).
- Recommended NPDP Certification (or Provisional Status) from Product Development and Management Association (PDMA).
- Innovation coaching included in the project.









Specific Restrictions

- No restrictions regarding the current employment status of applicants. However:
 - Employed applicants:
 - → Ensure their **participation does not involve** the use or exploitation of any data, confidential information, or intellectual property belonging to their employer.
 - → If their participation may affect their professional duties, they must obtain the necessary approval or permission from their employer.
 - → Ensure that their participation **does not violate any** confidentiality agreement, legal data protection obligation, or other **restrictions** arising from their employment.
- Responsibility for compliance with all relevant policies and legal obligations toward the employer rests solely with the participants.



Project Activities

- Development & validation of innovative ideas.
- > Prototype construction.
- > Intellectual property protection & business development.
- Legal advice for patents.

It is mandatory for the beneficiary to receive innovation coaching services as part of the project. It is also noted that all projects must comply with the "Do No Significant Harm" principle, as defined in the <u>RESTART Work Programme</u>.









Eligible costs

- Eligible costs **include**:
 - ✓ Costs for Instruments and Equipment (full cost)
 - ✓ Costs for External Services
 - ✓ Consumables
 - ✓ Special Costs
- Personnel costs and overheads are not eligible. X
- The cost categories are defined in the RIF's <u>RESTART Work Programme</u>.









Proposal Submission

The Project Proposal consists of the following parts:

- ✓ Application form (electronic via Google Form (fields) to be completed online).
 - Includes personal details, proposal description, and **3-minute pitch video in English.**

Evaluation & Project Selection

- Remote evaluation by one (1) independent evaluator (first-come, first-served).
- → Non-competitive procedures apply, on condition that proposals have been deemed eligible for funding according to the Call requirements.
- Evaluation Criteria:
 - → Innovation and Originality of the Idea.
 - → Business Potential & Market Need.
 - → Project Implementation.
 - → Suitability of the Applicant as an Entrepreneur.
- Eligible proposals are selected for funding, until the total requested funding of approved Proposals, equals the total Call budget.









Contract Preparation

- After the evaluation & the announcement of the results
 - Contract preparation for beneficiaries of eligible applications.
- Funding in two instalments: 70% advance, 30% after Final Report approval.
- Funding is provided as a lump sum, as De Minimis Aid (EU Regulation No. 2023/2831 of 13 December 2023) in two instalments, as described above.









Completion

Upon the completion of the assigned work the participants submits to the RIF:

- A brief Report using the «Progress Report» document
- A «Payment Request» which incudes invoices, proof of expenses, etc.
- ✓ If the total cost, according to the invoice issued, is lower than the value of the requested funding then the payment will correspond to the actual eligible cost.
- If any deviation from the conditions and regulations of participation, on the basis of which the funding was evaluated and approved, is found, RIF reserves the right to revoke the funding and/or exclude the individual from future related Calls.
