





Basic Principles / Requirements (1)

- ☐ Eligible Organisations should be based and operate in the areas controlled by the Republic of Cyprus
- ☐ A National DIH Consortium should consist of at least the following Partners:
 - A Research Organization (eg University laboratory with installed infrastructure, research center) that will be able to provide technological services and specializes in at least one of the technologies coved by DEP,
 - An Education Institution (eg Academic Institution, Vocational Training Institution),
 - A network of enterprises (eg business association, cluster) in the sector to be covered by the DIH.









Basic Principles / Requirements (2)

- ☐ Additional Organisations (business development agencies, competence centres, technology providers, commercial chambers, technology parks, investors, business angels, financial institutions etc) could participate as External Partners or Subcontractors.
- ☐ The participation of **RIF as External Partner** is recommended (to provide innovation support, technology transfer, IPR management and access to finance services)
- ☐ Each organisation may participate as Partner only in one Expression of Interest. External Partners are excluded.
- □ The Host Organisation could be the Research Organisation or new Legal Entity with non-Profit objective. DEP Work Programme: «A EDIH is a single organisation or a coordinated group of organisations with complementary expertise, with a not-for-profit objective.)









Basic Principles / Requirements (3)

- ☐ Thematic Priorities / Focus in at least one of the key technologies promoted in DEP:
 - **High Performance Computing**
 - Artificial Intelligence
 - Cybersecurity
- ☐ Application Areas / One or more Priority Sectors that have emerged through the Smart Specialisation Strategy (S3Cy):
 - Energy

 - Agriculture-Food Industry
 - **Built Environment and Construction**
 - Transport-Shipping
 - Health
 - Information and Communication Technologies
 - Sustainable Growth- Environment









Budget / Funding



- ☐ Digital Europe grant will fund 50% of the requested amount by the National DIHs
- Max. Funding by DEP: € 6,27 M (for 1 or 2 DIH from Cyprus)
- ☐ National Funding will cover 25% of the requested amount for:
 - Investment in tangible and intangible assets (i.e. equipment, software, hardware,
 - **Operating Expenses** (management of the DIH, organisation of training programmes, workshops and conferences, marketing cost to increase participation and visibility etc)
 - Costs for **innovation advisory** (consultancy, assistance and training in the fields of knowledge transfer, acquisition, protection and exploitation of intangible assets, use of standards and regulations) and support services (provision of office space, data banks, libraries, market research, laboratories, quality labelling, testing and certification)

Selection Procedure

- ☐ Evaluation/Eligibility Check by Evaluation Committee (Representatives from DMRID, MECI, DEC and External Observers)
- Evaluation/Eligibility Criteria
 - The minimum conditions regarding the composition of the Consortium are met.
 - The capacity and experience of the Consortium (infrastructure, HR) required to implement the activities and management of the DIH are documented.
 - The DIHs objectives and proposed actions are relevant to the DEP's Objectives and technologies promoted, and its application area falls within the S3Cy Sectors.
 - The Target Group, and the communication plan for the promotion of the DIH and engagement of the target group are clearly defined.
 - The response of the DIH towards the challenges of the local economy and the expected impact of the DIH's activities, are well documented.
 - The indicative budget for the development and operation of DIH is adequately described and includes the DIH 's commitment to provide own resources to co-finance its activities.
